Opposer B.O.L., a corporation of Delaware, doing business at 3100 Dupont Drive, Wilmington, Delaware, has been using the mark "Burn-Out Live!" since June 24, 1996 for "computer services, namely providing streaming audio and video via the internet" in International Class 38. "Burn-Out Live!" was registered on the Principal Register, U.S. Registration No. 3,062,476, on May 28, 1997. Section 8 and 15 Declarations have been filed.

Applicant Live, a corporation of Delaware, doing business at 6500 Nemours Lane, Newark, Delaware, filed trademark Application Serial No. 79/555,310 to register the mark, "BurnIT! Live" on April 4, 2002 for computer software, namely software for recording and copying to a DVD live or prerecorded audio and video streams obtained from an internet source," in International Class 9. Applicant first used the mark anywhere and in commerce on January 1, 2001. The mark was published for opposition in the Official Gazette on April 22, 2003, Volume 6000, No. 3, at page 715.
