**3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Patent and Trademark

5 Office Authorization Act of 1993".

# 1SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF AMOUNTS AVAILABLE TO THE2PATENT AND TRADEMARK OFFICE.

3 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
4 authorized to be appropriated to the Patent and Trademark
5 Office for salaries and necessary expenses the sum of
6 \$103,000,000 for fiscal year 1994, to be derived from depos7 its in the Patent and Trademark Office Fee Surcharge
8 Fund established under section 10101 of the Omnibus Budg9 et Reconciliation Act of 1990 (35 U.S.C. note).

10 (b) FEES.—There are also authorized to be made avail-11 able to the Patent and Trademark Office for fiscal year 12 1994, to the extent provided in advance in appropriation 13 Acts, such sums as are equal to the amount collected during 14 such fiscal year from fees under title 35, United States 15 Code, and the Trademark Act of 1946 (15 U.S.C. 1051 and 16 following).

17 SEC. 3. AMOUNTS AUTHORIZED TO BE CARRIED OVER.

18 Amounts appropriated or made available pursuant to19 this Act may remain available until expended.

20 SEC. 4. ADJUSTMENT OF TRADEMARK FEES.

Effective on the date of the enactment of this Act, the
fee under section 31(a) of the Trademark Act of 1946 (15
U.S.C. 1113(a)) for filing an application for the registration of a trademark shall be \$245. Any adjustment of such
fee under the second sentence of such section may not be
effective before October 1, 1994.
