

Question: "Fashion Wall Plates" published with adequate copyright notice also appear in catalogue published on same date with inadequate notice--is registration in order for the "Wall Plates."

Applicant has submitted for registration two copies of the catalogue entitled "The American Gentleman Fashions Spring & Summer 1940" published January 20, 1940 which bears an inadequate copyright notice--the notice is printed on the last page. This application must be rejected. In the same parcel with this application the Office received another application for registration of "American Gentleman Fashion Wall Plates." These consist of prints showing mens' wear, and the copies bear an adequate copyright notice; the date of publication given as January 31, 1940. They also appear in the catalogue bearing the title "The American Gentleman Fashions Spring & Summer 1940" for which application as stated has been submitted.

In the opinion of Mr. Wise, Mrs. Brady and Mr. Smith both applications should be rejected. All the material submitted has been published with inadequate copyright notice. The separate prints filed bearing adequate notice are identical with those appearing in the book bearing defective notice, and since the same date of publication is given in both applications no purpose is believed served by making a registration to cover only the prints--"Fashion Wall Plates." Mr. Pierce on the other hand takes the position that registration for each sheet of "American Gentleman Fashion Wall Plates" may be made upon receipt of applications on Form A-1. He does not feel that the inclusion of this material in a book published with inadequate notice should cause our rejection of a publication bearing adequate notice.
