Question: Division of opinion as to whether the domicile of Maurice Maeterlinck in the United States should be questioned.

The application filed gives the citizenship of Maurice Maeterlinck as Belgium and his place of domicile in the United States as c/o Dr. Saul C. Colin, 30 Rockefeller Plaza, New York City." The examiner is disposed to question this as a place of domicile since it is a business address and she has seen statements in the newspapers that Mr. Maeterlinck is visiting in the United States. Mrs. Brady sustains the examiner.

Mr. Smith and Mr. Wise, on the other hand, feel that the application should be accepted, both having seen statements in the paper that Mr. Maeterlinck fled from Belgium, and there seems little likelihood that he will be returning in the very near future, *this fixed abode has as yet undetermined*
