**JOINT MOTION TO AMEND NOVEMBER 22, 2002 SCHEDULING ORDER**

The parties submit that the following proposed schedule for calendar items after today's date will most effectively allow the parties and This Court to prepare for the trial in this action, scheduled to begin on February 24, 2003:

Filing of Pretrial Stipulation	January 17, 2003
Replies to Pretrial Motions	January 22, 2003
Filing of Proposed Jury Instructions and Proposed Verdict Form	January 31, 2003
Pretrial Conference	February 5, 2003 at 4:00 p.m.

The amendment to the schedule is being requested because, under the current schedule, eight reply briefs to oppositions to motions in limine, deposition counter-designations and the pre-trial stipulation are all due this week – a schedule which is unworkable. The proposed schedule will allow all pre-trial motions to be fully submitted well in advance of the pretrial conference and the trial. Further, the proposed schedule allows sufficient time for the parties to complete the pretrial order and jury instructions while still giving the court sufficient time to review them prior to the pretrial conference.


